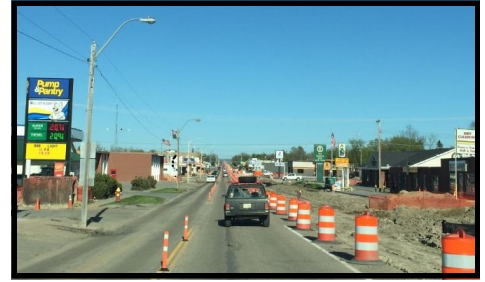

### Who Should Attend

The Safety Training Workshops are designed for **all** water/wastewater operators, natural gas, and electric technicians along with parks and street department workers dedicated to a safe workplace. We also would encourage attendance of all city officials such as city council members, board members, superintendents, etc., in order to gain further knowledge about the rapidly changing industry.

Credit toward recertification for **water operators (Grades 1-4) – 5.0 hours** and **wastewater operators – 5.0 hours applied for**, for attending a day-long seminar.
