About the Workshops

Who Should Attend

The Safety Training Workshops are designed for **all** water/wastewater operators, natural gas, and electric technicians along with parks and street department workers dedicated to a safe workplace. We also would encourage attendance of all city officials such as city council members, board members, superintendents, etc., in order to gain further knowledge about the rapidly changing industry.

Credit toward recertification for **water operators (Grades 1-4) – 5.0 hours** and **wastewater operators – 5.0 hours**, for attending a day-long seminar.

Registration and Fee

Participants are welcome to preregister no later than one week before attending the workshop of their choice.

Registration also will be available at the door on location of the workshop. Fees for the workshops are **\$65 per person for members and \$75 per person for nonmembers**, which includes lunch and learning materials. Fee may be prepaid or direct billed.
