2023 Rubber Gloving School

Tentative Program

Beginners:

The beginner's section is for those individuals with very little exposure/experience. This section will cover the basics of rubber gloving and line work.

Discussion Points:

Importance of a job briefing, and complete one for each new job during this training

Proper care of equipment and cover-up

The amount of cover-up needed for different jobs

Selection of tools and cover-up for the job

Inspection of equipment (includes PPE)

Truck inspection

Truck positioning and set-up

Proper grounding of trucks/equipment

Use of an extend-o stick/shotgun

Use of wrap locks/armor rod/ties

Work/Jobs

Insulator change-out (pole top and cross-arm)

Cross-arm change out on single phase

Bell change-out on single phase dead-ends (pole and arm)

Single phase pole change-out

Changing out a transformer on an energized pole

Other activities will take place, as time permits.

Intermediate:

This section is for those individuals who have experience, rubber gloving. They will cover situations that utilities deal with on a day to day basis. This group will be discussing different ways to do a job and then decide on the best method that will apply in their particular situation.

Discussion Points:

Complete a job briefing for each new job

Work/Jobs

Inspection, set-up and general training on Digger Derrick and Bucket Trucks

Classroom on electrical apparatus (Regulators, Breakers).

Hands on training with a Transformer Trainer

Changing out a transformer using methods other than a bucket or digger derrick.

Change out "field side insulator or bell" while set up on the road.

Other jobs may be added/substituted for the ones listed above.

Advanced:

This section is for those individuals who have extensive experience in rubber gloving. They will be performing tasks that aren't routine. They will use their experience and knowledge to "think outside of the box" on more complex jobs and decide on the safest and best method to perform the task at hand.

Discussion Points:

Complete a job briefing for each new job

Work/Jobs

Change out a three-phase dead-end and an angle structure energized

Change out crossarms on different structures energized

Change out a cutout and an arrester that are mounted on a riser pole or on a three-phase bank, keeping the primary underground energized or bank energized.

Other jobs may be added/substituted for the ones listed above.
