Note: Each participant should provide his/her own personal protective equipment such as long sleeve shirt, personal hand tools, aerial basket safety harness, lineman work boots, rubber gloves/sleeves, hardhat, safety glasses, and work gloves. NO TENNIS SHOES will be allowed in the training area, work boots are required.

2024 Rubber Gloving School
Tentative Program:

Beginners:

The beginner's section is for those individuals with NO or very little exposure/experience to gloving so far in their career. This section will cover the basics of rubber gloving and line work.

Discussion Points:

Importance of a job briefing, and complete one for each new job during this training
Proper care of equipment and cover-up
The amount of cover-up needed for different jobs
Selection of tools and cover-up for the job
Inspection of equipment (includes PPE)
Daily Truck inspection
Grounding or barricading the trucks and equipment
Use of an extend-o stick/shotgun
Use of wrap locks/armor rod/ties
Truck set-up and using a blocker vehicle such as a pickup truck parked back a ways
Covering Up, ALL DIFFERENCES OF POTENTIAL ON THE STRUCTURE.
Talk/share/discuss near misses.
Other basic line work

Tasks:

- *Insulator change-out (pole top and cross-arm)
- *Bell change-out on single phase dead-ends (pole and arm)
- *Installation and removal of a transformer on an energized pole
- *Refusing off a pole, out of a bucket truck and using a long stick

- **Single phase pole changeout

Other activities may take place, if time permits.

Intermediate:

This section is for those individuals who have limited experience, rubber gloving. They will cover situations that utilities deal with on a day to day basis.

Tasks:

- *Cut in and cut out temporary bells (Isolating a section of line).
- *A three phase lift, cross-arm change out
- *Changing out a transformer out of belt and hooks
- *Suspension Trama (discussion, rescue, and repelling).
- *Classroom on electrical apparatus (Regulators, and Breakers).

- **Change out a transformer bank
- **Installing repair sleeves

- *=Main Stations,
- **=Backup Station if needed for time.

Other jobs may be added/substituted for the ones listed above.

Advanced:

This section is for those individuals who have years of experience in rubber gloving.

Tasks:

- *Lean a three phase tangent pole, set a new pole and transfer conductors to new pole
- * Cut-in a C-8 and cut-out, change to a tangent structure

- Transformer banker trailer
- **Change out bells on a C-4 structure

- *=Main Stations,
- **=Backup Station, if needed.

Other jobs/trainings may be added/substituted for the ones listed above.
